1. **If** is included in the form **taswn**. There is no need to say **os**.

Baswn i'n dod taswn i'n gallu. *I would come if I could.*
Baswn i'n helpu taswn i ddim yn gweithio. *I'd help if I wasn't working.*

2. Weithiau dych chi'n clywed shortened versions:

taswn i	'swn i
taset ti	'set ti
tasai fe/hi/Ceri/y plant	'sai fe/'sai hi/ 'sai Ceri/ 'sai'r plant
tasen ni	'sen ni
tasech chi	'sech chi
tasen nhw	'sen nhw

3. tasai _____ gyda fi *if I had _____*
tasai _____ gyda nhw *if they had _____*

lit. *if there were _____ with me/ them.* Tasai is always at the beginning and we change the person at the end, like with other tenses:

Mae pen tost gyda fi.
Roedd pen tost gyda fi.
Bydd pen tost gyda fi.
Basai pen tost gyda fi.
Tasai pen tost gyda fi...

4. Pan dych chi'n dweud **if** yn Gymraeg, mae amser dau hanner y frawddeg yn cytuno. Mae hyn yn wahanol yn Saesneg:

Baswn i'n mynd **tasai** hi'n braf.
I would go if it were fine. (**lit.** *if it would be fine*)

Bydd a i'n mynd os **bydd** hi'n braf.
I will be going if it is fine. (**lit.** *if it will be fine*)
